Oil Painting SUPPLY LIST



There are many supplies to choose from but only a few are needed to start an oil painting. We recommend purchasing professional grade paints.

We offer a \$5/class materials fee but it will be student grade paints.

Experienced painters, with supplies, may bring in what they have and make any amendments for the painting they will be working on.



The minimalist supply list for beginners

- Primaries: Cadmium Yellow Light, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson or Permanent, Ultramarine Blue (call to discuss options)
- 12"x18" Grey Matters palette paper
- Brushes (portraits buy Filberts, all others Long Flats)
 Hog Bristle brushes: asst sizes 10, 6, 3
 Synthetic brushes: size 5 and 3
- Small, Age Refined Linseed oil or Tubed gel
- Palette knife #
- Light Blue pastel pencil and sharpener
- Paper towels (cloth like Viva or blue shop towels)
- 9"x12" Primed Canvas sheet pad (Centurion Deluxe Oil Primed Linen canvas pads, Arches Oil Paper, or Strathmore Oil Painting Paper)
- 11x14 Masonite board to tape on canvas sheets
- 3/4" Masking tape (beige)

Optional conveniences

- Masterson Sta Wet palette box for palette paper
 Glass w/gray paper underneath or New Wave Palette
- Odorless Mineral Spirits in a spring loaded turp can (no glass at the studio)
